YELLOW JACKETS/ WASPS

SEE SOMETHING...SAY SOMETHING...

Every month we will focus on specific pests that plague residents here in the Northwest. This month we will focus on Yellow jackets/ wasps. With the weather getting warmer you will notice more yellow jackets and wasps as they are more active with warmer temperatures.

Yellow jackets feed on other insects as well as scavenge on human food or garbage. Yellow jackets are more likely to sting when disturbed which can cause severe allergic reactions in some people.

To ensure that your area is free from yellow jackets and wasps make sure you are keeping all food covered, this includes all sugary drinks. Keep garbage covered, closed and taken out regularly in order to keep the wasps from scavenging the food that is there. Do not leave ripe fruit and/or rinds of fruit out. This is perfect food for yellow jackets and wasps eat off of.

Keeping a clean house and community can help tremendously in keeping yellow jackets away. There is an attachment that you can look at to reference for yellow jacket prevention. Please report all signs to the housing department as soon as you see them. This will ensure that it is taken care of before it becomes an issue.
