PUYALLUP TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 250719

WHEREAS, the Puyallup Tribe has existed since creation as the aboriginal people who are the owners and guardians of their lands and waters; and

WHEREAS, the Puyallup Tribe is an independent sovereign nation, having historically negotiated with several foreign nations including the United States in the Medicine Creek Treaty; and

WHEREAS, the Puyallup Tribal Council is the governing body of the Puyallup Tribe in accordance with the authority of its sovereign rights as the aboriginal owners and guardians of their lands and waters, reaffirmed in the Medicine Creek Treaty, and their Constitution and Bylaws, as amended and approved by the Tribe and the Assistant Secretary of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, Article II and Article VI of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Puyallup Tribe grant the authority to enact ordinances governing future membership in the Tribe; and

Amendment to Section 1.04.030 of the "Enrollment Code" changing Committee meetings to the Wednesday following first Friday of each month.

BE IT ENACTED by the Puyallup Tribal Council of the Puyallup Tribe, to become effective immediately upon approval by the Puyallup Tribal Council the following amendment to Section 1.04.030 of the Enrollment Code:

1.04.030 Enrollment Committee.


...

(b) The date and time of regular Committee meetings shall be the Wednesday following the first Friday of each month starting at 12:00 p.m. The schedule of regular meetings shall be posted by the Enrollment Director at the Enrollment Department's office, in conspicuous places at the Tribal Administration Building and on the Tribe's website, if available. Changes may be made as necessary in the date or time for any regular meeting; provided, notice of changes in the meeting schedule shall be posted in the locations stated above in advance of the changed meeting date or time. The Committee may also call special meetings as needed to conduct its business, provided notice of any special meetings are posted in advance of a special meeting. [Res. 251113 (11/25/13) Appx. BE IT FINALLY ENACTED by the Tribal Council that it authorizes the Tribal Council Chairman (David Z. Bean) and in his absence, the Vice-Chairman (Bill Sterud) to execute this Resolution and other such required implementing documents as are required on behalf of the Tribe.

RE: Changing date of enrollment meeting

It has been brought to our attention that we may need to change the day that we hold our Enrollment Meeting with the Enrollment Committee to accommodate a better system to prepare for issuance of the Per Capita Payments.

Per the Enrollment Code, Subchapter 2, Section 1.04.030 (b), it states that: ***The date and time of regular Committee meetings shall be the Wednesday following the second Friday of each month starting at 12:00pm.***

It was scheduled for that date and time in order to give new applicants the opportunity to be able to submit all their documentation to our office in time for the Enrollment Committee meeting.

It can be changed to: ***The date and time of regular Committee meetings shall be the Wednesday following the first Friday of each month starting at 12:00pm.***

This would require applicants to submit their documentation by the first Friday instead of the second. It would also allow Per Capita to have additional time in preparing for any/all new enrollees.

The Enrollment Code, Subchapter 2, Section 1.04.030 would need to be amended to reflect the change along with notification to tribal members.

Please advise of any action taken on this matter.
