


Election Drive-Thru Process



Out of abundance of caution and to minimize risk, the Election Board humbly requests that all voters wear some type of face mask when pulling up to the Polling Place.

ENTRANCE

- 1. Entrance to the "No Campaign Zone" is <u>located behind the Chief</u> <u>Leschi elementary school field</u>.
- 2. <u>Visible campaign materials</u> are not permitted past this point.
- 3. This <u>includes bumper stickers</u>. Supplies and security assistance will be available to cover any campaign material that cannot be removed from a vehicle.

CHECK IN

- 1. Please pull your vehicle up to the 1st tent located near the stadium.
- 2. Have **photo ID** ready for all voters in your vehicle. (If you do not have an ID, you may sign a <u>Declaration of Identity</u> **OR** be <u>verified by at least (3) Election Board members</u>.)
- 3. Voters will each be provided with a pen to keep.
- 4. Sign next to your name as usual.
- 5. Voters will be provided with a clipboard and their ballot.

VOTING

- 1. Please pull your vehicle up to the 2nd tent.
- 2. Voters are asked to <u>cast their votes in their vehicles during this</u> <u>time</u>. Voters may vote for <u>one (1) or two (2) candidates</u>.
- 3. Voters will remove their ballots from their clipboards and return their clipboards to an Election Board member for sanitization.
- 4. Voters will **pass their ballot, upside down**, to an Election Board member.
- 5. Voters will then observe an Election Board member feed their ballot into the voting machine.
- 6. Voters will be provided with their <u>voter number</u> and/or <u>sticker</u> if they wish before exiting the polling area.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Absolutely <u>no "Walk Up" voting will be permitted</u>. The Election Board asks that voters stay in their vehicles throughout the voting process.
- Please be patient with Election Board members as this process may take longer than voters are typically used to.
